



At Neroche Community Primary School we take very seriously our responsibility to prepare children for life in modern Britain. We ensure that the fundamental British Values are introduced, discussed and lived out through the ethos and work of our school.

Neroche Primary School is developing a high quality approach to promoting British Values. Our School Council is the key to delivering this part of the curriculum. Our School Council are actively engaged in local campaigns of their choice such as our half termly Food Bank Collections, surveys regarding school uniform and approaching the School with suggestions from the pupil body. Our Co-operative Status enables us to meet the demands of promoting British values. All of our Trust Schools met with our MP for a democracy day before the last general election to investigate British democracy.

To enable our school to prepare our pupils for life in modern Britain, we are currently preparing joint visits and developing formal links with a large primary school in Luton, Bedfordshire. This school is very diverse with in excess of 30 Asian languages being spoken, a complete contrast to rural South Somerset. We are also working with the local Ilminster Twinning Committee to develop links with the primary school in Riec-sur Belon to both promote life in modern Britain and Mfl.

We have found this approach to be enriching for all parties as it teaches tolerance and respect for the differences in our nation's communities and the wider world.
